DOCTORAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP 2006 – 2007**

The ACT Fellowship is a one-year partial fellowship that supports HGSE advanced doctoral students conducting research on issues related to learners and technology. It is hoped that through the fellowship, issues critical to ACT will receive examination and visibility through the ongoing work of students at HGSE. Awardees are selected by the ACT Fellowship Committee of the Technology in Education Program, and are designated ACT Fellows.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS: Candidates must be HGSE advanced doctoral students (year D3 and above) who are conducting research on issues related to learners and technology.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: **MONDAY, MAY 15, 2006, 5 p.m.**

AWARD: \$2,500

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:: Applicants are requested to submit

- 1) The application form
- 2) A letter 2 pages or less in length which describes your current research on issues related to learners and technology
- 3) (optional) An additional statement describing any special circumstances affecting your progress to date is not required but suggested, if you feel that it will allow a more well-rounded review of your application.
