The nearby Redfern rail station provides a high degree of convenience for participants who intend to commute daily.

Accommodation

St Paul's College -Graduate House

Accommodation has been arranged at a group rate at Graduate House. Opened in 2018, it is situated on the campus and within easy walking distance to the Business School. Rooms are available on a first come, first served basis..

The package rate for 4 nights accommodation including breakfast and a welcome cocktail event on Sunday 12th January 2020 is \$908 incl gst per person. These are air conditioned, ensuite rooms, with queen beds.

Please note that principals will be organising and paying for their own accommodation, dealing directly with St Paul's College; the Harvard Graduate School of Education is not responsible for non-refundable travel arrangements or other planning expenses incurred. We recommend that you not make lodging and travel arrangements until you are admitted to the program..
